Button Pusher/Page Turner

A Button Pusher/Page Turner can provide an easy grip for someone with limited finger and hand control.

Materials:


1 - 3/4" to 1" dowel purchased in a hobby, art, or hardware store

1 - unsharpened pencil with eraser

Drill with ¼" drill bit Hand saw

Directions:

- 1. Measure and saw the dowel in 5 ½" sections.
- 2. Drill a ¼" hole in each section of dowel located at the midpoint and about ½" deep.
- 3. Push the lead end of the pencil into the hold and glue if necessary.
- 4. Repeat the process for each remaining dowel section.
