Ring on a Mouse

By adding the loop of the ring to the mouse, it helps individuals that have a hard time keeping their finger on the left trigger.

Warning: May be a choking hazard for kids 5 and under

Materials:

Plastic Ring
Scissors
Super Glue/Hot Glue Gun/
Glue
Sand paper (optional)

Directions:

1. Cut the decorative piece of the ring off, leaving just the loop.
2. (OPTIONAL) Use the sandpaper and smooth out the surface being attached to the mouse.
3. Adhere the part of the loop that was previously attached to the decorative piece to the mouse.
4. Let the adhesive dry before using.

Helpful Hints: You can usually find the little fancy decorative rings at the dollar store or at a party store.
