

Make 'n Take Sheet

Discover How Easy It Is To Make Your Own Assistive Technology!

Basic Visual Schedule

A durable, water resistant (if laminated) visual schedule to help with organization, regulation, and transitions.

Materials:

1-page printed table with 2 columns indicating “things to do” and “all done” (can be created in Microsoft word)

1” x 1” icons that represent the activities “to do” (can be created using Google images, Boardmaker, Symbolstix, real photos, etc)

Velcro – both soft and scratchy sides

Page protector or laminator

Card stock (if laminator not available)

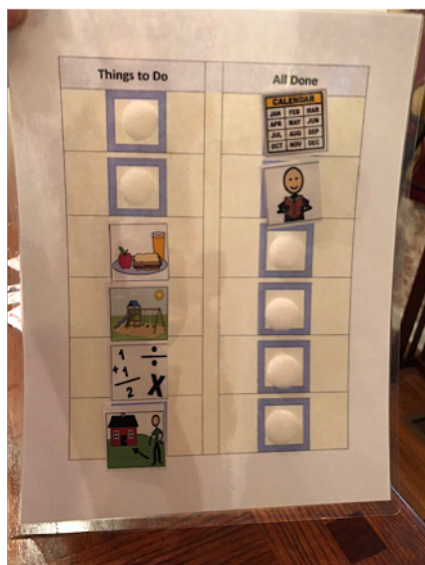
Ziploc bag

Directions:

1. Laminate the 1-page table indicating “things to do” and “all done” or place it in a sheet protector putting a small piece of clear tape on top so it doesn’t fall out
2. Generate the desired icons using picture program of choice
3. If unable to laminate the icons, print on card stock paper for more durability
4. Laminate and cut out the icons generated
5. Place soft-sided Velcro on the “things to do” page in all squares
6. Place scratchy-sided Velcro on all icons
7. Use Velcro to adhere the Ziploc bag to the back of the “things to do” table
8. Place extra icons in the Ziploc bag
