“Working for...” Token Chart

A durable, water resistant (if laminated) token chart to provide a visual support to goal and progress towards the goal for self-regulation, goal setting, and choice making.

Materials:

Card Stock

Velcro – both soft and scratchy sides

Icons that represent tokens (can be created using Google images, Boardmaker, Symbolstix, etc.)

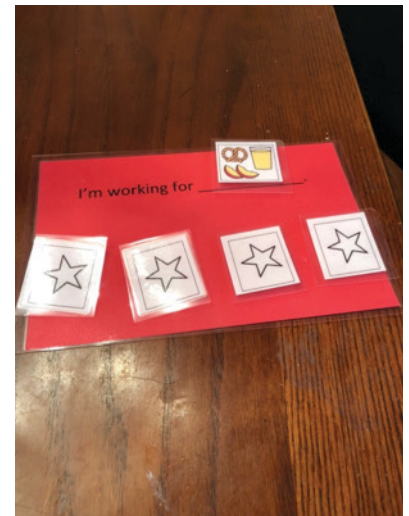
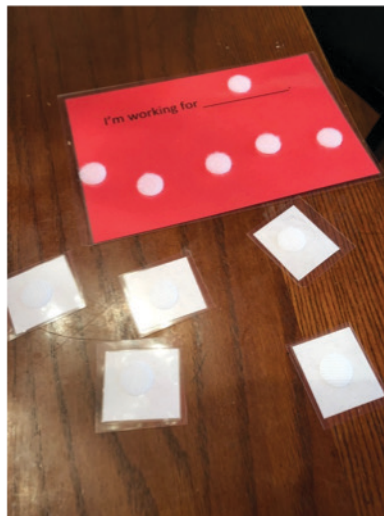
Page protector or laminator

Icons that represent targets

Ziploc bag

Directions:

1. Laminate the 1/2-page card stock indicating “I’m Working For” or place it in a sheet protector, fold in half and use clear tape to secure
2. Generate the desired icons using picture program of choice
3. If unable to laminate the icons, print on card stock paper for more durability
4. Laminate and cut out the icons generated
5. Place soft-sided Velcro on the “I’m Working For” page
6. Place scratchy-sided Velcro on all icons
7. Use Velcro to adhere the Ziploc bag to the back of the “things to do” table
8. Place extra icons in the Ziploc bag
