Description

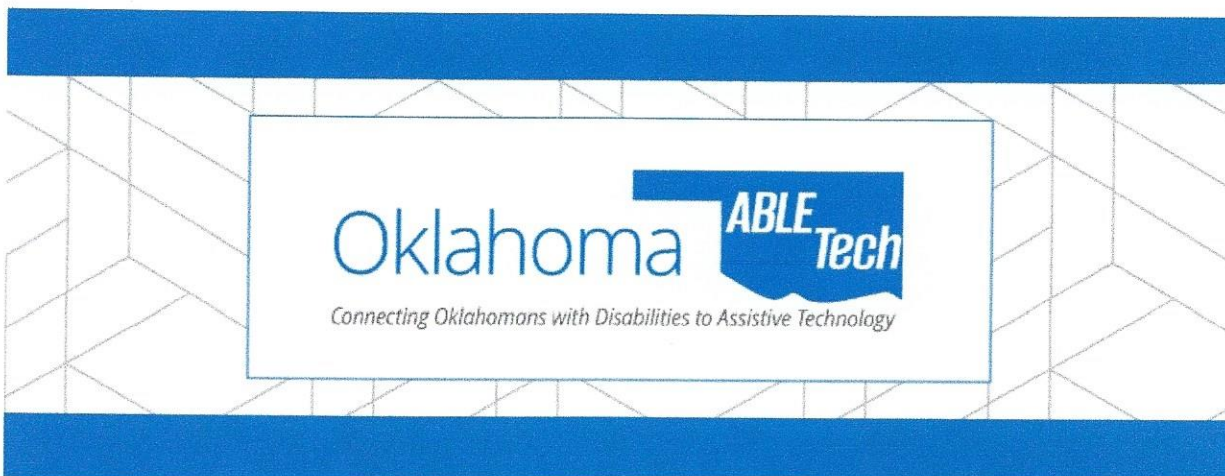
