Description

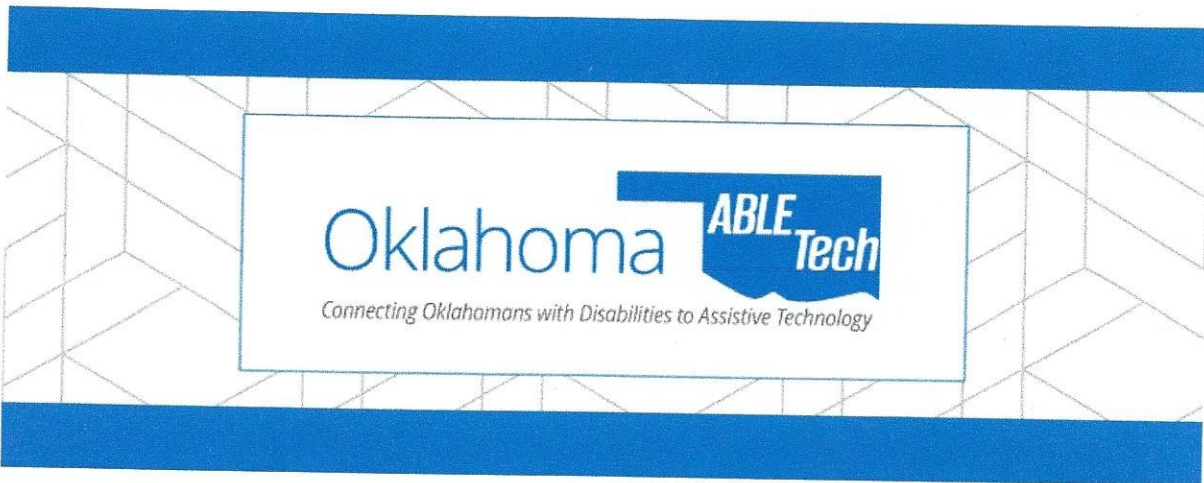
