The OSDH Pediatric Audiology Program's AT Library is in partnership with Oklahoma ABLE Tech, Oklahoma's Assistive Technology Act Program located on the campus of Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Oklahoma ABLE Tech promotes the availability of assistive technology (AT) devices and services for Oklahomans with disabilities. AT is identified as any item or piece of equipment used to maintain or improve the functional capabilities of people with disabilities. AT is also defined as a service that assists an individual in the selection, acquisition, and use of the AT device. AT allows people with disabilities to function more independently in employment, education, and community living activities.

### **AT Categories:**

## **AT Device Demonstration Program**

Purpose of Demonstration Program:

The purpose of the OSDH Pediatric Audiology AT Device Demonstration Program is to offer individual families exploration of specific hearing AT devices to assist in decision-making about device purchase or usage. The demonstration program is intended to offer guided experiences for individual families with a particular device, or group of devices, to support effective usage and provide any additional resources necessary, such as funding sources, vendors, and other product comparisons.



### **Policy:**

- The AT Device Demonstrations are available by appointment only
  - Families call the closest county health department where the OSDH audiology clinic is housed.
  - See below listing for contact information.
- If a child has not had a complete diagnostic audiologic assessment and Auditory Processing Disorder Assessment if appropriate, the OSDH pediatric audiologist will perform these assessments to determine appropriate recommendations.
- Device demonstrations are offered in person at no charge.
- Requests for equipment demonstrations may be made by a person with a disability, family members, advocates or service providers (e.g. therapist, teacher, rehabilitation counselor).
- The person requesting the loan may identify someone who will provide support during the loan period. Support persons may include teachers and speech-language pathologists or other providers.
- The borrower agrees to pay for any damage due to negligence
- If an individual/family is interested in borrowing a device after the demonstration, inquiry and coordination can be made with the ABLE Tech Short-Term Loan Program. The audiologist will assist family with this process. Please note that on occasion, a particular device may not be available for loan. Examples include: items in high demand or on a waitlist and modified vehicles.
